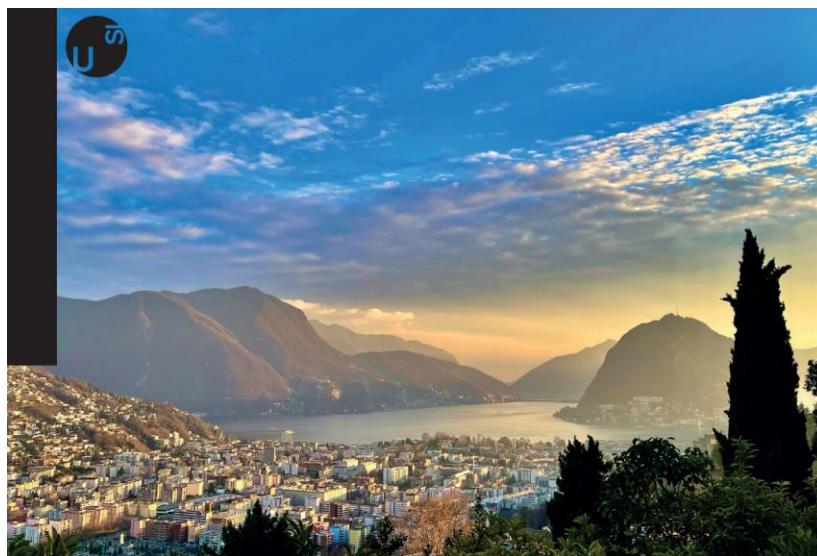

Viewing the fact that the situation concerning the war of Russia against Ukraine has not improved, the Scientific Committee has extended the temporary suspension of network members in organisations in Russia by further six months. The Scientific Committee will carry out a new assessment of the situation at the end of March 2024.

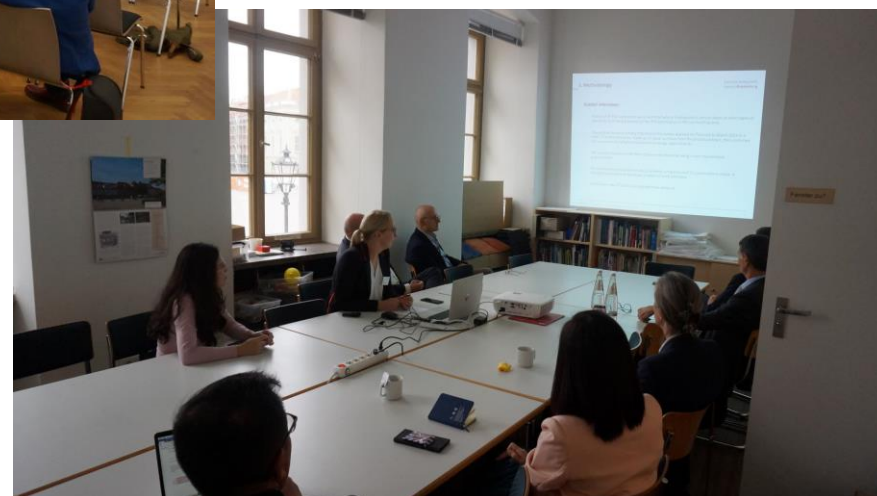
